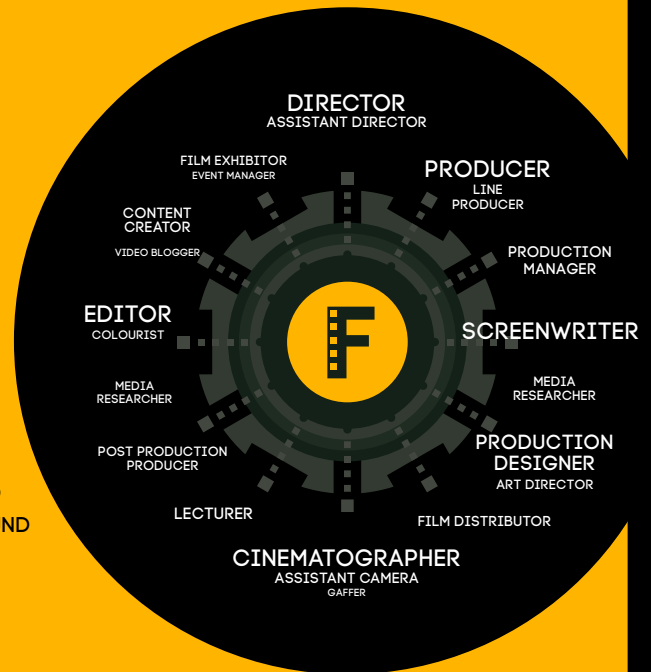
From narrative fiction to documentary, there are infinite stories to be told and the industry is constantly seeking out talented individuals with a distinct storytelling style and voice.
